

Performance License

This License is for K-12 schools only. By purchasing <u>Performance Royalties</u>, Your School automatically becomes the Licensee and is bound by the terms and conditions of this License. [Any other entity (including but not limited to youth theatre, college theatre, community theatre, professional theatre, or other type of business) must apply for a license and be granted permission to perform this play. Please visit <u>this page on actlikeyoumatter.org</u> to apply and receive a price quote.]

Definitions:

"<u>Licensee</u>": Your school, the Purchaser, and any adult who receives a copy of the Performance Script (including but not limited to teachers, drama teachers, Principal, administration, volunteer parents, etc.) Sometimes referred to herein as "You," "Your," and/or "Your School." <u>It is Your responsibility to make sure that each of the people and entities described in this paragraph have received a copy of this License.</u>

"Performance Script": The version of the script for Baffle Away Bullying! Interactive Stage Play for Audiences and Educators in K-3rd that must be used during rehearsals in anticipation of a performance for an audience of any size. Sometimes referred to herein as the Play. Access to this script is only available to those who purchase BOTH royalties (which results in this License) AND the Performance Script Photocopy License.

"Purchaser": The individual(s) or entity that purchased the Performance Royalties (including but not limited to the school's PTA, PTO, Foundation, District, etc.)

Any violation of these provisions shall automatically terminate this License.

I. Copyright Protection: All of the plays represented by Act Like You Matter, Inc. are protected under the copyright laws of the USA (copyright.gov) and all countries with which the USA has reciprocal copyright relations whether through bilateral or multilateral treaties or otherwise. Any time one of our plays is presented in front of an audience, a Performance License (per performance), royalty fees (per performance), and Performance Script Photocopy License are required, regardless of the size of the audience or whether or not an admission fee is charged. Any unauthorized performance of our plays constitutes an infringement of the copyright and a violation of the law, with potentially serious consequences to the infringer, including fines.

- II. Non-Exclusive Rights Granted: This License granted to the Licensee allows the public and private performance of Baffle Away Bullying! Interactive Stage Play for Audiences and Educators in K-3rd (the "Play") as represented in the Performance Script under the following terms and conditions:
 - 1. Number of Performances Allowed: The royalty fees paid are per performance; for example, one (1) royalty fee allows You to perform this Play one (1) time. When You purchased Performance Royalties, You indicated the number of times You would be performing this Play, and You paid for that number of performances. That is the number of performances allowed. If You are unsure how many Performance Royalties you purchased, please contact customerservice@actlikeyoumatter.org.
 - 2. Required Purchase of Performance Script Photocopy License: To be able to perform this Play, Your School must purchase BOTH royalties (which results in this License) AND the <u>Performance Script Photocopy License</u>. Performance of this script without also purchasing the Performance Script Photocopy License is strictly prohibited and constitutes a violation of copyright law. This License grant NO rights to be able to photocopy or print the Performance Script. Performance Script Photocopy Licenses may not be shared or transferred.
 - 3. **Use of the Performance Script:** Performances of the Play must be rehearsed using the Performance Script reproduced under the terms of the Performance Script Photocopy License issued by Act Like You Matter, Inc. You may not make any copies of the Performance Script unless You have purchased the Performance Script Photocopy License, which is a required purchase to be able to perform this Play (see Section II, Paragraph 1).
 - 4. Changing the Performance Script: Under federal law, You may not make any changes, including but not limited to the following:
 - a. You may not add new music, dialogue, lyrics, named characters, or anything to the text.
 - b. <u>You may not delete</u>, in whole or in part, any material in the Play, unless the Performance Script states that a specific portion may be deleted if the audience is losing focus.
 - c. You may not make changes of any kind, including but not limited to changes of lyrics or dialogue or change in the period, characters or characterizations, unless the Performance Script states that extra, non-speaking, unnamed student characters may be added.
 - d. Notwithstanding the conditions of this Paragraph 3, Subsections a-c, if Your performance of this play is open to the public and not a private performance exclusively for the benefit of students at a school, you may change references to "your school," "your teacher," and "teachers" to be more relevant to your venue and audience. For example:

- i. "Your school" might be changed to "here"
- ii. "Your teacher" might be changed to "the adult you came here with"
- iii. "Teachers" might be changed to "adults"

5. Recording/Reproduction (Audio, Video, etc.)

- a. Recording: You may not make, use, and/or distribute a digital or mechanical recording (rehearsal, performance, or otherwise) of the Play or any portion of it by any means whatsoever, including, but not limited to, audio, video, film, CD, DVD, streaming video, video on demand, and other digital sequencing. An Archival Video License is available for Purchase from actlikeyoumatter.org; all terms and conditions of the Archival Video License are contained in that document. This Performance License grants NO archival video rights, other video rights, or recording rights of any kind.
- b. Broadcast: You may not broadcast, televise, and/or electronically post on the Internet any part of the Play, either audio or visual or both.
- c. <u>It is Your responsibility to make sure that all cast, crew, director, stage manager, and artistic team (the "Production Team"), parents, guardians, and all audience members are aware of the restrictions of this Paragraph 4.</u>
 - i. We strongly encourage You to remind everyone at the beginning of each rehearsal about these restrictions.
 - ii. At the beginning of each performance, You must announce the following to the audience:

"This Play is protected under federal and international copyright laws. Video recording of this performance is strictly prohibited. We will subject to penalties, including fines, if anyone records and/or broadcasts any portion of the Play."

- 6. **Photography:** You may take pictures of rehearsals, dress rehearsals, performances, and actors in costume, and post online, subject to the following conditions:
 - a. You must include the following language when You post online:

"From Baffle Away Bullying! Interactive Stage Play for Audiences and Educators in K-3rd by Amy Jones Anichini. Visit actlikeyoumatter.org to learn more."

- c. <u>It is your responsibility to make sure that the Production Team, parents, guardians, and anyone who watches a rehearsal or performance is aware of the restrictions of this Paragraph 5.</u>
- 7. Admission: Your School may charge admission for the audience to see the performance(s) and retain all proceeds from ticket sales without owing any compensation to Act Like You Matter, Inc.
- 8. Distribution of My Game Plan for Playing Baffle Away Bullying ("My Game Plan Handout") to Each Audience Member: During the Performance, My Game Plan Handout is mentioned many times by the characters in the Play. The members of the audience know that they will be receiving it. You are responsible for making sure that someone, including but not limited to or any member of the Production Team, gives a hardcopy of My Game Plan Handout to each audience member. We strongly recommend distributing the handout in one of the following ways:
 - a. If your performance is open to the public, please give copies of the handout to the adults accompanying the children as they enter your venue; then, at the end of each performance, stand by the exits with extra copies in case you missed anyone on the way in.
 - b. If your performance is private and for the benefit of students at a school, please give pre-counted stacks of the handout to the teachers, after their students are seated but before the performance begins.
- 9. Creating Hardcopies of My Game Plan Handout: My Game Plan Handout is located in the back matter of the Performance Script, immediately following the final scene (Scene 14) of the Play. This Performance License grants NO photocopy rights of any kind. The Performance Script Photocopy License contains the rights and restrictions with regard to photocopying or printing any part of the Performance Script, including My Game Plan Handout, and preparing it for distribution to the audience.

10. Program/Poster/Advertising Credits:

a. Author Credit: You must give credit to Amy Jones Anichini (the "Author/Copyright Owner") as sole and exclusive author of the play in all programs distributed in connection with performances of the play and in all instances in which the title of the play appears for purposes of advertising, publicizing or otherwise exploiting the play and/or a production thereof; the name of the author must appear on a separate line in which no other name appears, immediately beneath the title, as follows:

- "Baffle Away Bullying! Interactive Stage Play for Audiences and Educators in K-3rd by Amy Jones Anichini"
 - b. Publisher Credit: You must give credit to Act Like You Matter, Inc. on all posters, fliers, advertisements and on the title page of your programs as follows:
 - "Produced by special arrangement with 501(c)(3) nonprofit Act Like You Matter, Inc. (actlikeyoumatter.org)"
 - c. You must include the following warning in your program:
- "Videotaping or other video or audio recording of this production violates copyright law and is strictly prohibited."
 - d. Merchandise: You may not create merchandise based on the Play, whether for sale or distribution, without written permission from Act Like You Matter acting on behalf of the Author/Copyright Owner.

III. Other Provisions

- 1. Expiration Date of License: This License shall expire 12 months after the purchase date of the Performance Royalties, whether or not You have performed the Play. We strongly encourage You to secure your performance dates before or promptly after purchasing the Performance Royalties. Should unforeseen circumstances (such as the COVID-19 pandemic of 2020) prevent You from being able to perform this Play before the License expires, please contact customerservice@actlikeyoumatter.org to request an extension or refund.
- 2. **Additional Performances:** If You add performances after purchasing your Performance Royalties, simply purchase more royalties (one per added performance) here: <u>Performance Royalties</u>.
- 3. **Warranty:** Act Like You Matter, Inc. warrants that, on behalf of the Author/Copyright Owner, it is authorized to grant this License to You. Act Like You Matter makes no other warranties.
- 4. **Reserved Rights:** All rights in and to the Play other than those specifically licensed to You under the terms of this License agreement are reserved to Act Like You Matter.

- 5. Transfer of Rights: Under no condition can this License be assigned or transferred without written consent from Act Like You Matter. This License shall be governed by the Laws of the State of California, and any dispute arising out of or under this License agreement shall be litigated only in the courts of the City of San Diego or the State of California or the United States District Court for the Southern District of California, and in no other forum.
- 6. **Indemnification of Licensor:** You agree to indemnify Act Like You Matter and the Author/Copyright Owner of the Play from any claim arising out of Your violation of any of the provisions of this License agreement.
- 7. Limited Rights: This authorization applies to Performance Rights only for K-12 schools only. All other rights that are not specifically addressed in this License of every kind and nature, including but not limited to photocopying or printing scripts, using scripts in rehearsals or for classroom readings, television, video or audio, in whole or in part, or any other form of mechanical or electronic reproduction, such as information storage and retrieval systems, recording, and web pages, are reserved by the Author/Copyright Owner and are not included in this authorization. Reproduction of any kind, including for personal use, is also strictly prohibited.
